A most els sale r and be two oden floorboards were installed when the barn was converted. The high vaulted ceiling still features the original beams. French doors are now in place at the from and, with the addition of several windows, there is plenty of light. The area of the barn is approx 12.46 x 5.94 m. With the high vaulted ceiling, the barn remains as a single large open room. With wonderful sound acoustics and good accesibility, this location would be particularly suited for TV and film shoot.
